





EcoPaperLoop Questionnaire on policy and regulations (February 28, 2013)

1 Introduction

EcoPaperLoop (Ecodesign for the Enhancement of Central Europe Paper Based Products Recycling Loop) is a currently running research project with participating partners from several CE countries. Its main objective is optimization of paper recycling loop in the region, particularly the enhancement of paper for recycling quality. This may only be achieved by increasing awareness among all concerned stakeholders and adoption of new policy guidelines, regulations and legislation regarding ecodesign, improved collection strategies as well as recycling technologies.

The main objective of this questionnaire is to obtain information on knowledge and implementation of current EU and local legislation, regulations, directives, laws, decrees and other legal documents in the field of collection, sorting, recycling, recovery, use and trade of paper and board for recycling, and final products made from recovered and recycled fibres. **The second objective is to obtain proposals** for improvements which would be the basis for new legislation in this area.

2 Content

The questionnaire addresses the main stakeholders involved in paper and board recycling loop as well as Public authorities; it consists of four main parts:

- 1. **respondents affiliation**, status, responsibility in paper and board recycling loop, general data about institution or company,
- 2. **information about current paper streams,** objectives and goals of paper recycling, recyclability issues, quantities and quality of collected paper within the country, region, company ...,
- 3. **information about the implementation of EU and local legislation**, directives, laws, decrees ...
- 4. proposals for new regulations (voluntary schemes, guidelines, new legislation ...
