Our common goal: Improving the quality of paper for recycling. Raising awareness and provide tools to enhance the recyclability of paper products as well as the collection of paper for recycling in the Central Europe region. This shall secure the quality of the raw material for the paper industry and reduce the environmental impact as much as possible.

EcoPaperLoop Improving the quality of paper for recycling

- We develop a laboratory method to assess the recyclability of paper based packaging. Details on the EcoPaperLoop website!*
- We will propose a scorecard with relevant parameters to evaluate the recyclability after the assessment.*
- We set up a database that allows to compare the quality of paper for recycling in the different regions.*
- We develop and perform life cycle analyses (LCA) for selected graphic and packaging products.*
- A respective software tool helps to apply and vary the LCA.*
- We survey regional and local regulations and policies.*
- Then we develop a roadmap to implement the project results into strategies and regulations to improve the quality of paper for recycling.*

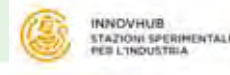
